The cameras could thereby project the television picture onto a monitor visible to all. On the left side of the stage are three arm chairs and on the right side a bar table and three bar stools for moderator, love, justice.

the participants by his bad behavior, or a team (man and woman) could be formed by two moderators who share the leadership).

righteousness personalized quality of righteousness - cast with a woman !?

Audience present at the performance, may actively participate in the combat and on the competition themes, determine the winner of the combat.

Moderator Now there remain these three faith, hope, love, but the greatest of these is

love.

Righteousness Of these three I can agree!

Love modestly Not just these three!

Moderator There is nothing bigger?

Righteousness Yet, righteousness.

Love Anyone can claim that.

Righteousness Righteousness of course, requires this claim to be proven.

Moderator But is not well known that love is the greatest?

Love Exactly. We could ask the audience right now.

Moderator Do not rush, we will do that later.

Righteousness I know that I do not have the best reputation. That is not my fault. Time and

again others have masqueraded as righteousness.

Moderator Like the scribes and pharisees?

Righteousness Exactly, but I had nothing to do with these hypocrites.

Moderator Nothing?

Righteousness At least not much.

Moderator One had a lot to do with them.

Love But then the "righteous ones" killed him.

Moderator How was that possible?

Love godly love has permitted it.

Righteousness godly righteousness.

Moderator who or what killed him in the end? love or righteousness?

Love bad guys had flocked together. But their success was short-lived and only

temporary.

Righteousness Until today, they have flocked together and their success has been going on

for quite some time and is not only temporary.

Moderator We have flocked together, or have come together to give you both, Love and

Righteousness, the opportunity to succede.

Love Success originates from the heart.

Righteousness Success originates from the head.

Love From one heart to the next.

Righteousness From one head to all others.

Moderator We will see.

#### 2. Interview

Moderator introduce yourself. What's your name? And what's not your name?

Righteousness I am the Righteousness. My name is not Revenge! I do not seek avenge, not at

all to avenge myself. I'm not called justice either. I'm not trying to judge. I'm

not the justice either. Even the law does not meet my requirements.

Love I am the love. I am not mercy, because I do not only have compassion. I'm not

the patience, because I'm not just enduring. I'm not the kindness either. Even

to name me goodness would not be righteous.

Righteousness I like hearing righteous out of your mouth.

Love It was a pleasure for me.

Moderator Please describe your character with adjectives. Please limit yourself to what

you are not. What you are sometimes reproached, but what is not true.

Righteousness I am not self-righteous, not partial, not overcritical, I am not jealous, not

hypocritical.

Moderator And what are you by no means?

Righteousness Certainly I am not heartless!

Love I'm not unrealistic, I'm not indifferent, I'm not scared, I'm not blind.

Moderator And what are you by no means?

Love For sure I am not stupid!

Moderator We also do not want to be stupid. What do you mean by "I'm not indifferent"?

Love answers, but Moderator interrupts and asks first the viewers.

Love I am willing to watch for a while without intervening obviously, but that does

not mean I do not care about the matter or person. Instead of openly

criticizing, I try to move people in a clever, hidden way to cause them to make

the necessary changes themselves. I am always ready to offer my help.

Moderator to Righteousness And what do you mean by "I'm not jealous?"

Righteousness answers, but moderator interrupts and asks first the viewers.

Righteousness If I criticize something or someone, really consider it unfair and like to correct

or improve. My motivation is not envy, I do not begrudge a party or person,

nor do I want to take personal advantage.

# 3. Reasons for participation

Moderator And why do both of you participate in this competition at all?

Love I have the impression that love has been pushed into the background in recent years. I want to remind everyone that love is so important. And besides, it's for a good purpose, because I can do a lot of good with the prize money.

Moderator If you should win. to Righteousness And why do you participate?

Righteousness Love has been overrated in the past. I think we've been on the right track for a few years now. But we need more righteousness. But this requires persuasion. That's why I'm participating. And not because of the prize money, with which I can only do a little good.

Moderator If you should win. But we are not that far yet.

4. Image of the opther

Moderator describe how you see your opponent. With three properties, but with three

positive characteristics that you appreciate.

Righteousness Only three?

Moderator Yes, only three, we do not have time the whole evening. Both think.

Love At least three?

Moderator Do you hear poorly? At least you are not blind. shows three fingers three!

Exactly three! I hope you'll find them. Both think. However, we do not have

time the whole evening.

Love What I appreciate about my opponent is ...

Moderator And stay always positive.

Righteousness to Love I value the unshakable trust on your part. Where I have long given up

faith, even doubt, you hold fast to the sinner.

Love to Righteousness I appreciate your courage. You mess with everyone in case

you seem to be right. And in case it seems to be necessary. And you take risks

and disadvantages for yourself - and others as well.

Moderator Always remain positive. Like the truth last week.

Love with a view to Righteousness who has truly recommended wisdom.

Righteousness truth could not help it.

Love truth has remained faithful to itself.

Righteousness It has not achieved much.

Righteousness Or this endless patience. You are abused, insulted, lied to and still do not

become angry.

Love You stay so cool. While I show – have to show - my innermost feelings to

others, you show no emotion.

Moderator I said positive, without hidden criticism!

Love That was just a well-intentioned suggestion.

Moderator Fine, then let's try again. Positive, without hidden criticism or "well

intentioned suggestions".

Righteousness What impresses me is your selflessness. You give and give and give until you

have nothing left to give.

Love And I am impressed by your critical faculty. You are constantly criticizing even

for making little improvements.

Righteousness Do you know what critical faculty means?

Love Keeps silent

Moderator I think so. Because something love is certainly not - stupid!

Righteousness I understand.

Moderator

Moderator Excellent 2: 2.

Moderator to the audience and who wrote that? (Apostle Peter)

Moderator Now quotes with love and / or rigteousness appear, whereby additionally a second word is missing. So it's about supplementing the two missing words. Who knows it pushes the buzzer. One point plus for each correct word, one point minus for each wrong word., ok?

Righteousness thinking fruits of the spirit. Then faith must not be missing.

Moderator But where.

Righteousness Definitely not in last place.

Moderator So at third?

Righteousness Yes.

Moderator Wonderful. That's it ... But one fruit of the Spirit is still missing.

Moderator The last one. But that does not mean that it is of least importance.

Moderator Laura Branigan could sing a song of it!

Moderator stands up and dances Oh, the night is my world!

Love stands up City light, painted girl.

Righteousness stands up In the day nothing matters

Love it's the night time that flatters.

Righteousness you take myself

Love you take my self control!

Moderator You take mayself, you take my self control. Uh, so?

Love and Righteousness sing and dance together "I, I live among the creatures of the night"

Moderator And?

Love and Righteousness But I have got the will to try and fight. 3,2,1 self control.

Moderator One point for both of you!

Righteousness and still be able do other satisfying things.

Love That's why we have to reduce the workload.

Righteousness And distribute fairly.

Moderator But how do you pay the rent?

Love Limit the rent.

Righteousness Increase incomes.

Moderator Unfortunately, this is not allowed everywhere. - In order to form an opinion, one also needs reliable information.

Moderator at least it is beneficial.

Righteousness with a smile Nevertheless, many refrain from reliable information.

Moderator with a smile But not from their own opinion.

Righteousness again serious It is better of course to know facts and connections!

Love again serious and backgrounds and motivations.

Moderator but how do you ensure that this information is available?

Love press freedom.

Righteousness press commitments.

Moderator and what should the publishers commit themselves to?

Righteousness to the separation of facts and fictions.

Love to the separation of news and opinion.

Moderator And how do you want to ensure that?

Love internal control by media.

Righteousness external control by the public.

Moderator Nevertheless, there are always false reports.

Love false reports should not be.

Righteousness... allowed.

Moderator but if?

Love should the people in charge apologize.

Righteousness misrepresentations are not really excusable.

Moderator and therefore be punished?

Righteousness they should pay compensation.

Love and correct the matter.

Moderator And what about the audience?

Love much depends on the attitude of the audience.

Righteousness and on the demands of the audience.

Moderator What should the audience watch over?

Love Viewers should not assume that the news is objective, and there are always other opinions and alternatives.

Righteousness They should not assume that the media and journalists are independent. They have their own constraints, interests and views.

Moderator What should the broadcasters beware of?

Righteousness and me to democracy - worldwide.

Moderator And where are rights and kingdom of God?

Love Of course, God should get justice.

Righteousness God should of course not be excluded.

Moderator That will make God happy.

Moderator Let's stay with us and our neighbors.

Love We should our neighbors our friends.

Righteousness And partners.

Moderator But what is the basis of friendship or partnership?

Love Shared Values and Mutual Respect.

Moderator And how do you want to achieve that?

Righteousness Joint Projects and Mutual Exchange.

Moderator But what if someone does not want friendship?

Righteousness We are all in the same boat.

Moderator smiling Not only us, but we'll come to that later.

Love we are one big family.

Moderator but in every family it comes to arguments now and then.

Love that mostly is not worth mentioning.

Righteousness conflicts must be settled.

Moderator Or should not arise at all?

Righteousness That's why we need global righteousness. Global righteousness is the prerequisite for international peace and security.

Love We need global love. Global aid agencies that alleviate the suffering of disadvantaged people.

Moderator Are you looking for a new international order?

Righteousness We need big changes to achieve a just globalization.

Love and sustainable.

security policy

Moderator Otherwise, foreign policy can also affect internal affairs. This brings us to

terror.

Love terror arises fears and constraints.

Righteousness vice versa.

Moderator and how do you want to free people from it?

Love Love can free them.

Righteousness righteousness.

Love we have to love people. Even our enemies.

Righteousness and treat all people fairly. Even our friends.

Love because until now love is missing.

Righteousness and righteousness.

Moderator Maybe wisdom as well? But that comes back next week.

Love The causes are complex.

Righteousness and global.

Moderator Globally, there are more and more refugees.

Love Of course, love requires us to take in refugees.

Moderator all?

Love We can not let people die!

Righteousness all should accept refugees.

Moderator who relies on the others ...

Righteousness we need agreements.

Love all hold on to.

Righteousness and a spirit of solidarity.

Love a spirit of brotherhood.

Moderator But can we afford it?

Love Can we afford to do nothing?

Righteousness We also afford a lot of other things.

Moderator Maybe we afford too much? Does not the state already have enough debts?

Love The debts could have been paid off long ago.

Righteousness Everyone who has debts should pay it back.

Love If the repayment is possible.

Moderator but what if repayment is not possible?

Righteousness It was possible to make debts.

Love Best if no one can store debts.

Moderator But what if someone has debts?

Love I can write off debts.

Righteousness I can help to pay back debts.

#### budget policy

Moderator lets's come to budget policy.

Righteousness I favour education.

Moderator But education is expensive.

Love stupidity is even more expensive.

Moderator how do you want to finance it?

Love Stupidity or education?

Righteousness Education is self-financing.

Love stupidity too.

Moderator to Love Can you not stop these jokes?

Love I could, but the audience wants to be entertained, or?

Moderator But this is a competition. to righteousness So, how should education finance itself?

Righteousness education leads to success. Success to profit. Profit to taxes. Taxes to finances. Finances to education. The audience wants to be convinced.

Love stupidity leads to failure, failure to loss, ...

Moderator interrupts - Thanks, that's enough.

pensions

Moderator Retirees are unlikely to finance themselves.

Love except the young ones take care for their age.

Righteousness Have to.

Moderator How much should everyone have in his old age?

Righteousness Everyone should have a basic pension.

Love That he can supplement by contributions.

Love If he wants.

Righteousness he does not have to.

Moderator Who has worked more should also get more pension?

Righteousness Who works more in retirement.

Moderator And what about the time before the retirement?

Righteousness Before the retirement, he got more money for his work.

Love Hopefully.

Righteousness Why should he still get more money now, when both are not working anymore?

Love After all, he had deposited more.

Moderator Who pays more in the health insurance also gets a better treatment.

Righteousness Not in the statutory health insurance.

Moderator Therefore there are the private ones. So the higher earners can also get a better treatment.

Righteousness Why should the higher earners everywhere be better off? They are already better off because they earn more. Should anyone who pays more taxes also attend better schools? And get the better seats in the theater? Those who earn more pay more taxes. That is how at least some balance can be achieved.

Moderator to Love What do you say to this?

Love Who earns more, has not necessarily earned more.

Moderator Last question for both of you: How do you want to prevail in society?

Righteousness requires to reward righteousness and to punish

unrighteousness.

Righteousness requires education, morality, moral courage,

commitment and an eye for minorities. But above all, just structures

that leave no room for unrighteousness! In a fair society, the

individual has responsibility for society and society for the individual.

Love Love requires to promote love and overcome indifference.

Love Love requires heart-building, morality, compassion, sacrifices and an eye for

the needy ones. But above all charitable organizations that leave no room for

indifference. In a loving community, I take care of my neighbor and my

neighbor takes care of me.

#### Behavior in the discussion

Love

looks at the individual, its desires, needs, fears, hardships, suffering and limitations,

is concerned, compassionate, humorous, behaves kind, polite, considerate, gives examples, praises the efforts and achievements, encourages action, conversion,

remains optimistic and describes a fine future.

Righteousness openly addresses social ills, needs and goals.

sees the groups, their compositions and interests, remains factual, serious,

objective

criticizes what has been omitted and what has not been achieved

acts consistently, punishes, dismisses, condemns

remains pessimistic and warns.

Moderator provokes, doubts, interrupts, involves audience.

#### 9. Catch word round

Note: It is not strictly predetermined who first responds (love or righteousness), except in the case of freedom where love is the first. Love and Righteousness respond naturally and spontaneously, faster, slower. Interrupt each other and are interrupted.

Moderator This brings us to the catchword round. I give you a keyword and you give a short statement. Are you ready? The first keyword is:

Moderator evil

Love I do not count the evil.

Righteousness I do not neglect the evil.

Moderator Wrong doing.

Love I forgive wrong doings

Righteousness I fight against wrong doings.

Moderator Mistakes

Love I endure the mistakes of others.

Righteousness I correct the mistakes of others.

Moderator Feelings

Love I include feelings

Righteousness I exclude feelings.

Moderator Reasonableness

Love I am indulgent.

Righteousness I am consistent.

Moderator Heart

Love I can be soft-hearted.

Righteousness I can be hard-hearted.

Moderator Eye

Love I can close one eye.

Righteousness I have to keep both eyes open.

Moderator Truth

Love I can keep the truth to myself.

Righteousness I have to tell the truth to others.

Moderator Why this?

Love I do not want to harm the individual.

Righteousness I want to benefit society.

Moderator Faith

Love I believe first.

Righteousness I check first.

Moderator Prejudices.

Righteousness I judge all the same.

Love I evaluate all individually.

Moderator Trust

Love Healthy trust is better than morbid mistrust.

Righteousness Healthy mistrust is better than blind trust.

Moderator Hope

Love I hope the best.

Righteousness I fear the worst.

Moderator Freedom

Love I grant people liberties.

Righteousness what people actually enslaves.

Love You take liberties from people.

Righteousness that actually sets people free.

Moderator Unity

Righteousness I am the foundation of unity.

Love I am the bond of unity.

Moderator Marriage

Love I am for marriage.

Righteousness I am for partnership.

Moderator Humans

Love The indidual is in the center.

Righteousness Society is in the center.

Moderator Talents

Love I grant everyone to make good use of his talents.

Righteousness I urge everyone to increase his talents.

Moderator Humility

Love I can make myself smaller than I am.

Righteousness I do not make myself smaller than I am, but also not taller.

Moderator Interests

Love I do not look for my own interests.

Righteousness I consider the interests of all.

Moderator Solution.

Love I am the solution.

Righteousness I'm just a try.

Moderator How that?

Love If everybody loves its neighbor, everyone is loved.

Righteousness I can only try again and again to treat everyone fairly and appropriate.

# 10. Scales of justice

Moderator Imagine you are on Judgment Day. And you have to decide the fate of people.

What criteria will you put onto the scales?

Love Do we really have to judge?

Righteousness I do not think so.

Moderator Try it anyway. We are concerned with the fundamental attitude to judgment.

What is loving? And what is fair?

Righteousness What criteria are available?

Moderator That's up to you. Which criteria play a role?

Love Human criteria.

Righteousness Divine criteria.

Moderator Oh, you mean the divine scale.

Righteousness Therefore, I calibrate the scales first with the godly righteousness.

Love and I with godly love.

Moderator The scalesare already calibrated. Goes to a builtup scale, next to it are a series

of larger (heavier) and smaller (lighter) boxes. What do you put on the scales? Label the boxes with your criteria and place them on one of the two sides. If the right side weighs heavier, the person is saved, in the other case it is - not saved. You have 3 minutes. You can lay the boxes on the outside, then they weigh heavier or more towards the middle, then they weigh less. Are you

ready? Then start - NOW!

Love labels a big box with "+ deeds" and places it on the right side of the scales Good

deeds I put the good deeds of a man on the scales.

Moderator And what about the bad deeds?

Moderator to Love And now?

Love The good thoughts.

Moderator to Love I see you make any effort.

Love I have to take care of the lost sheep.

Righteousness And the bad thoughts.

Moderator to Righteousness I see you make also efforts.

Righteousness Someone has to take care of the other - sheep.

The balance again indicates "not saved".

Moderator to Love And now?

Love The bad that he has rejected.

Righteousness And the good he has failed.

The balance again indicates "not saved".

Moderator to Love And now?

Love The repentence that he showed.

Righteousness The turn around he did not do.

Moderator Righteousness is obviously striving for justice.

The balance again indicates "not saved".

Moderator to Love And now?

Love the difficult circumstances.

Righteousness the favorable conditions.

The balance again indicates "not saved".

Moderator to Love And now?

Love shortly before the end of time Then I put the mercy on the balance. Puts one more box on the scales and prevents righteousness from adding another. And so mercy rejoices over the judgment.

Moderator At least it triumphs here in the studio. An applause for our candidates.

Righteousness Is that fair?

Love Mercy?

Righteousness No, I mean the whole judgement procedure.

Love To outweigh the good and the bad against each other?

Righteousness thinks That can not be the solution.

Moderator You are not satisfied? How so? I think love and righteousness will be fine.

Love It is superficial.

Righteousness And very primitive.

Moderator It was just a game.

Love How long does the game - the Judgment Day - actually last?

Righteousness Thousand years.

Love Enough time to - earn credit.

Righteousness And how do you earn credits?

Love Humans are good - from the inside.

Righteousness Nevertheless, humans vanish - also from the outside.

Love We have to help them, of course.

Righteousness And create appropriate conditions.

Love We must promote good.

Righteousness And stop evil.

Love It will be fine.

Righteousness but not easy.

Moderator Before you drown in your thoughts, I suggest that we continue. The wisdom will come back next week, maybe it can contribute to the solution.

#### 11. Necessity

Moderator Is there a way without you? Please convince us that nothing works without

you. I give the start and you complete the sentence. The first keyword is Faith.

Moderator What does faith lead to without love or without righteousness?

Love Faith without love makes fanatic.

Righteousness Faith without righteousness creates unbelief.

Moderator The next keyword is knowledge.

Love knowledge without love makes haugthy.

Righteousness knowledge without righteousness creates destruction of knowledge.

Moderator The next keyword is power.

Love Power without love makes you cruel.

Righteousness Power without righteousness creates powerlessness.

Moderator The next keyword is wealth.

Love Wealth without love makes you stingy.

Righteousness Wealth without righteousness creates poverty.

Moderator And now, in turns. Once you and then you. Looks at Love. Let's start with you.

Conscientiousness.

Love Duty without love makes you petty.

Moderator to Righteousness Peace

Righteousness Peace without righteousness creates strife.

Moderator to love Kindness

Love Kindeness without love makes hypocritical.

Moderator to Righteousness Honor

Righteousness Honor without righteousness creates dishonor.

Moderator to Love wisdom

Love wisdom without love makes you proud.

Moderator to Righteousness Freedom

Righteousness Freedom without righteousness creates bondage.

Moderator to Love Righteousness

Love Righteousness without love is inhuman.

#### Moderator to Righteousness Love

Righteousness Love without righteousness creates laziness.

Moderator So what is all worth without you?

Love Without love everything is nothing. Even if I speak with angelic tongues and

have no love, I am just a resounding cymbal. And if I have all the gifts, but no love, that is of no use to anyone. And if I give everything I have, but only to

praise myself, it will not do me any good.

Righteousness Without righteousness everything is nothing - less than nothing. For if I speak

with the tongue of God, but not words of righteousness, then I only cause

damage. And if I have faith to move mountains, but no deeds of

righteousness, then I only cause damage. And if I give everything I have, but

not to the friends of righteousness, then I only cause damage.

#### 12. On the lifeboat

Note: Love and Righteousness pantomime. As a prop a save boat for two people with two paddles can be used or the save boat, like the third person in the boat, only imagined.

Moderator Then let's see how good you are in situation analysis and how you prove yourself under time pressure. It takes three minutes. Imagine you two are in a boat with another person. Somebody else is in the water. You have to figure out what's up and solve the problem by asking questions. Alright? Then we start. Starts the timer.

Love how did we get into the lifeboat?

Moderator Your ship has just sunk into the sea. But you have made it into the lifeboat.

Love And what about the person in the water?

Moderator The person did not make it.

Righteousness Then we have to bring the person into the boat.

Moderator There is no room left in the lifeboat.

Love We can not let the person drown!

Moderator The person still holds on to the boat.

Righteousness How cold is the water?

Moderator Icecold. Looks at the stop-watch. The person will only endure 2 minutes and 30 seconds more. Time is running.

Love Who is the person in the water?

Moderator A child.

Love Then there is almost the whole life in front of it!

Righteousness Or almost behind.

Love But we can not let the child drown!

Righteousness Why does the child not get into the boat?

Moderator It would be too heavy. The boat is built only for two people.

Love I trade places with the child!

Righteousness Who is the third person on board?

Moderator A terrorist.

Love What?

Righteousness What did he do?

Moderator He caused the ship to sink.

Love What a rogue!

Righteousness Do you still want to trade with the child?

Love Perhaps the terrorist can trade with the child?

Righteousness You can ask him!

Love or be exchanged.

Righteousness And how do you want to do that?

Moderator By the way, the child in the water is getting cold. But it only has to looks at the stop-watch freeze for two minutes more.

Love We have to do something!

Righteousness We have to overpower the terrorist.

Moderator That should be difficult.

Love Why? There are two of us.

Moderator The terrorist has a gun in his hand.

Righteousness What shall we do?

Moderator I did not understand you.

Love What shall we do?

Moderator I'm sorry, the child in the water is always shouting "Help, I'm drowning!"

Love I have to jump into the water!

Righteousness And how can I cope with him alone?

Moderator The terrorist says you should row.

Love And if I do not want?

Moderator Ask the terrorist.

Love I do not row. And what?

Moderator He shoots you if you do not shut up. You should row.

Righteousness starts to row to Love Come on, we row!

Love is rowing too Where are we rowing?

Moderator To the shore.

Righteousness recognizes the opportunity How far is it to the shore?

Moderator Sorry, the child is crying again.

Righteousness How far is it?

Moderator 200 meters.

Love my child, hold on.

Righteousness hold on tight

Moderator One minute remains.

Love Why does not the terrorist row himself?

Righteousness Yes, he could shoot us and row without us.

Moderator No, he hurt himself by the bomb.

Love I hope he does not hold om.

Righteousness How far is it to the shore?

Moderator 150 meters.

Love And how is the child?

Moderator It is getting quieter. The cold.

Love and Righteousness row with all their power.

Moderator Now it has become very quiet.

Righteousness How much more?

Moderator 100 meters or 30 seconds looking at the stop-watch.

Righteousness jumps up and slams the pistol out of the hands of the terrorist.

Love pulls the paddle over the terrorist's head.

Righteousness Come, help me!

Love Yes, let's throw him overboard!

Love and Righteousness throw the terrorist overboard.

Moderator Congratulations. You did it. You got rid of the terrorist. Looking at the clock But the kid too. It canmot hold itself more above water. Time has expired.

Love I jump into the water. Jumps into the water.

Righteousness You have to dive!

Love I have it.

Moderator It is alive.

Righteousness My child, hold on to the paddle! pulls the child on board.

Love And what about me?

Righteousness Well, for my sake.

Moderator Applause for the two candidates! Until you have dried off, we can make a brief commercial break.

# 13.Advertisement stageplay "fruitage oft he spirit".

The advertisement is visible on the monitor.

Moderator Why always fight against each other? Why not colaborate with one another? We would like to draw your attention to the Great Controversy between the virtues and the vices.

Of course, all participants in this program will participate, that is, love, righteousness, wisdom and truth. Doubtful support they get from the faith. Together they fight with egoism, malice, fear and foolishness, though fear does not necessarily have to be an adversary.

A fight that is not just social and interpersonal.

Sometimes we are in conflict with ourselves, with our mistakes, weaknesses and desires.

The analysis of the virtues enables a clear and distinguishable awareness of the available positive forces with the aim to use them effectively. Do not let the evil defeat you, defeat the evil with the virtues!

Righteousness First of all, the next but one.

Love It is important that everyone is being loved.

Righteousness And everyone is treated fairly.

Love Righteousness prevails where love reigns.

Righteousness Love prevails where righteousness rules.

Love those who lack love, cry for righteousness! And laws.

Righteousness We need laws. Somehow the coexistence has to be regulated. As in traffic.

Love, Fine, I can agree in traffic. However, people did not come into existence for the sake of the traffic lights, but the traffic lights for the sake of men.

Love Just like the woman for the sake of mankind.

I am not jealous, I do not boast, I do not blow myself up, I do not behave indecent, do not seek my own advantage, do not let me provoke, I do not counting evil, I am not pleased with inrighteousness, but I am happy the truth, I forgive everything, believe everything, hope everything, endure everything, I remain for ever. I am the way of life.

Righteousness I am correct and demanding, impartial and incorruptible, do not make myself smaller than I am, take into account the interests of all, I am not flattering, I am consistent, do not neglect the evil, persecute unrighteousness, reveal the truth, Check whenever it is necessary, do not tolerate grievances. Moderator to the winner What will you do with the prize money?

A. If love is the winner

Love I donate the money for a good purpose. For the earthquake victims and

survivors.

Moderator And your final word of encouragement to our viewers?

Remain in love and love will remain.

#### B. If righteousness is the winner

Righteousness I support the construction of a school in West Africa with two-thirds of the money.

Moderator And what will you do with the remaining third?

Righteousness I do not know yet.

Moderator And your final word of encouragement to our viewers?

Righteousness "remain in Righteousness and righteousness will remain!"

Moderator Can I ask you for a short statement on the result of the election?

A. Comment of Righteousness after the lost election:

Righteousness Obviously, Righteousness is not very well received.

B. Comment of Love after the lost election:

Love I'm happy for Righteousness. And I wish her all the best.for the duel with the wisdom.

Moderator Goes among the audience asking for impressions on the show and election: Why did you vote that way, what did you like best, what do you expect for the final next week? Finally he says goodbye.
